Major Steps

1. Each member above must submit a new member application with this chapter application. Scan and send all forms to the email below, or mail to the address below. You can find this and other application forms on the Packet Info page at localcommonwealth.com.
2. Once you have submitted your application, all three charter members will receive the Local Common Wealth operating constitution. This details next-steps on setting up your organization. It is designed to maintain the thriving culture you will be creating. This is not a top-down leadership model. It is a culture of consent, and approximately 25% of this constitution is designed by Local Common Wealth, the parent vision, and the other 75% will be designed over time by the local chapter.
3. Begin selecting members. You must have twenty-five members with this Form, Member Applications, and Absence Fee Agreement and all fees paid to the Chapter before you can begin weekly networking.
4. One of the founding visionary members of Local Common Wealth will attend that first networking day.
